NOTE: Sometimes processing an *American Express* card is more costly; some providers automatically cover it, others pass the additional % on to you. Some providers also charge a slightly higher percentage for reward cards or other “boutique” credit cards. Be sure to ask about Amex and Rewards cards transactions. Some also provide for “Debit Cards Only” options, to discourage taking on consumer debt to pay a one’s pledge—which is a good idea, but may limit participation. People might value the rewards, i.e. airline miles, for paying pledge online.
